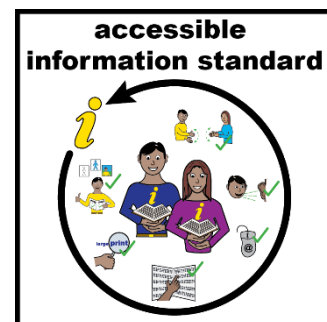
We value your privacy and keep your data safe.



Why we collect your data?

To serve you better, fundraise, and fulfil our responsibilities.

Sometimes, not sharing your data might mean we can't serve you.



What we collect & how we use it?

Supporters: Your contact details to keep you updated on our activities, fundraising, and other services.

Learners: Your contact and health details to serve you better and ensure safety. Also, financial info if you pay us.

Parents/Guardians: Contact info for emergency purposes, ensuring safety, and if you're paying us, financial details.



When might we use your data due to "legitimate interests"?

Understand feedback, research, improve services, maintain public profile, work with partners, keep a record of any objections, and during any change in MK SNAP's organisation.

Legal points

Sometimes, we must collect data due to legal reasons, especially for health and safety.



If there's a legal claim or if the police or other authority ask, we might need to share your data.

How long we keep your data?

Supporters: Up to 7 years after your last interaction.

Learners/Parents/Guardians: Up to 6 years after your last attendance.

Who might we share your data with?

IT providers for technical reasons.

Legal or regulatory bodies if required.

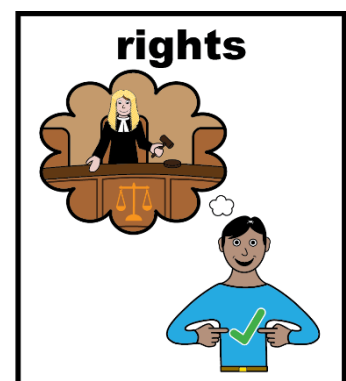
Any shared data is made anonymous.

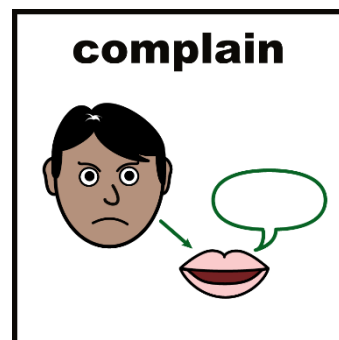
